POLE CONFIGURATION

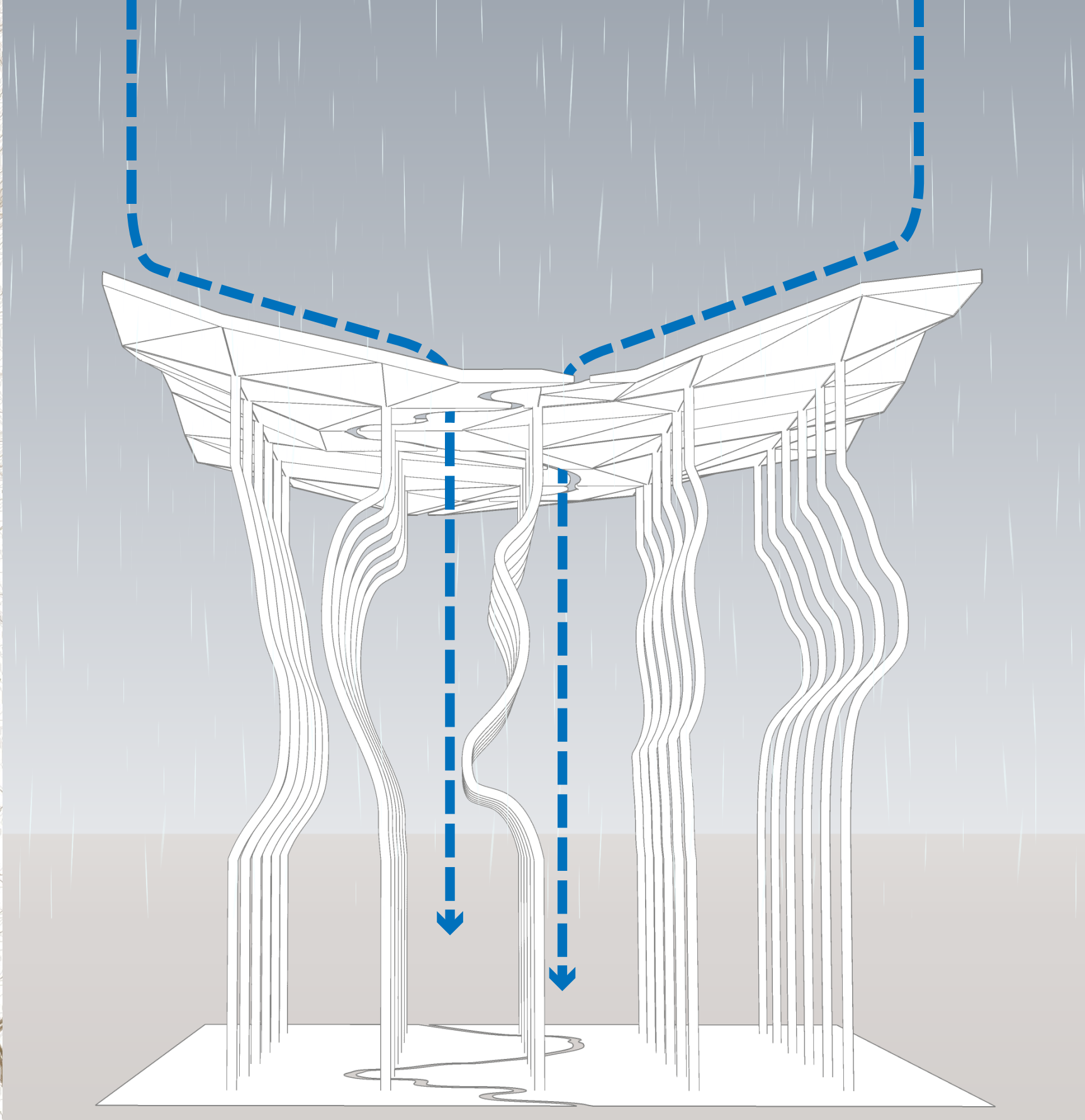
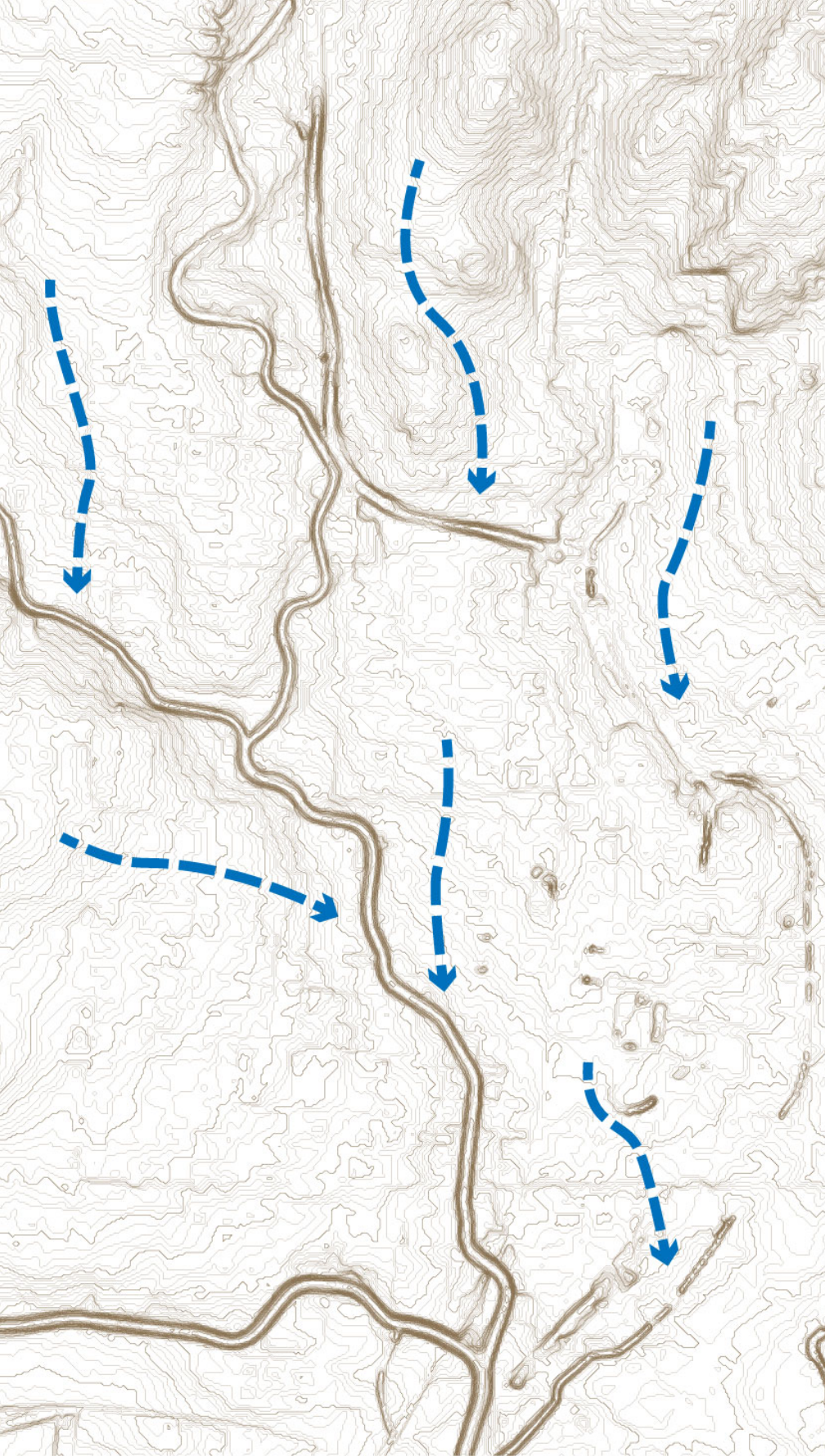

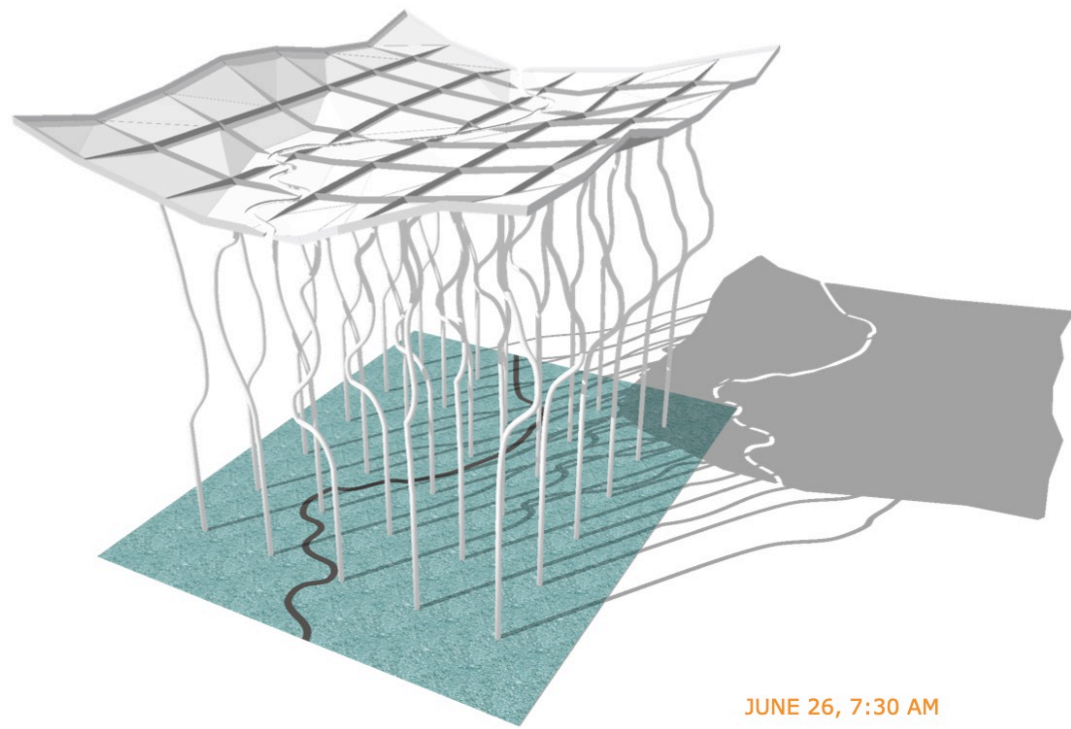


CANOPY AS WATERSHED

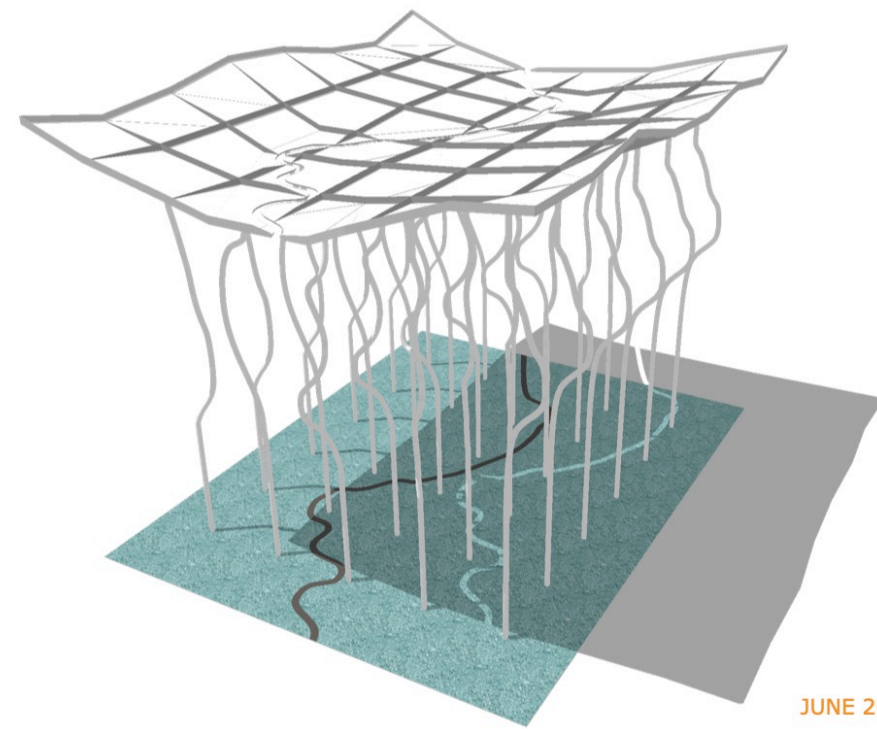




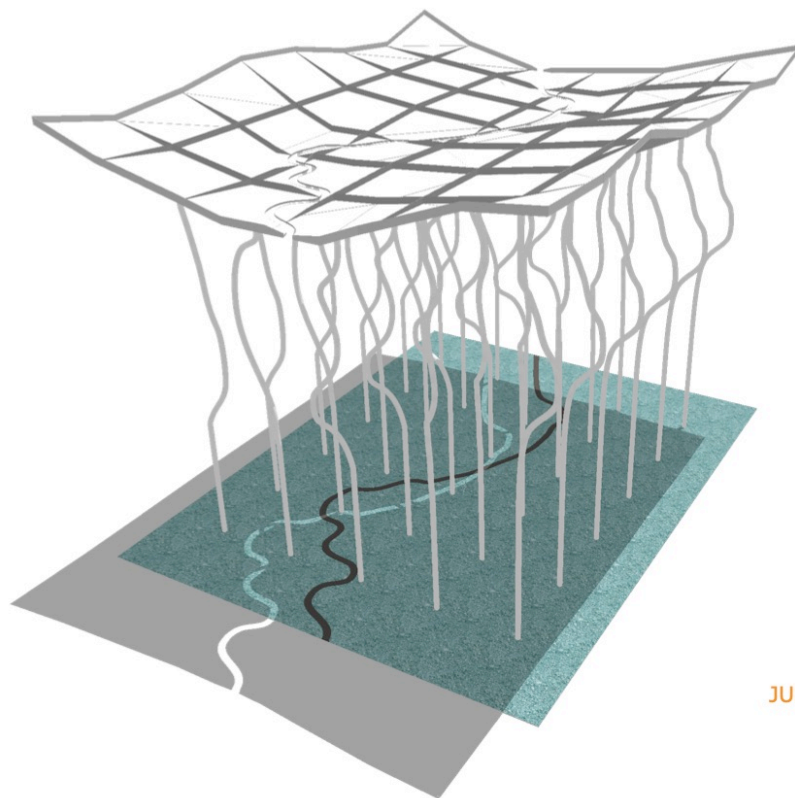




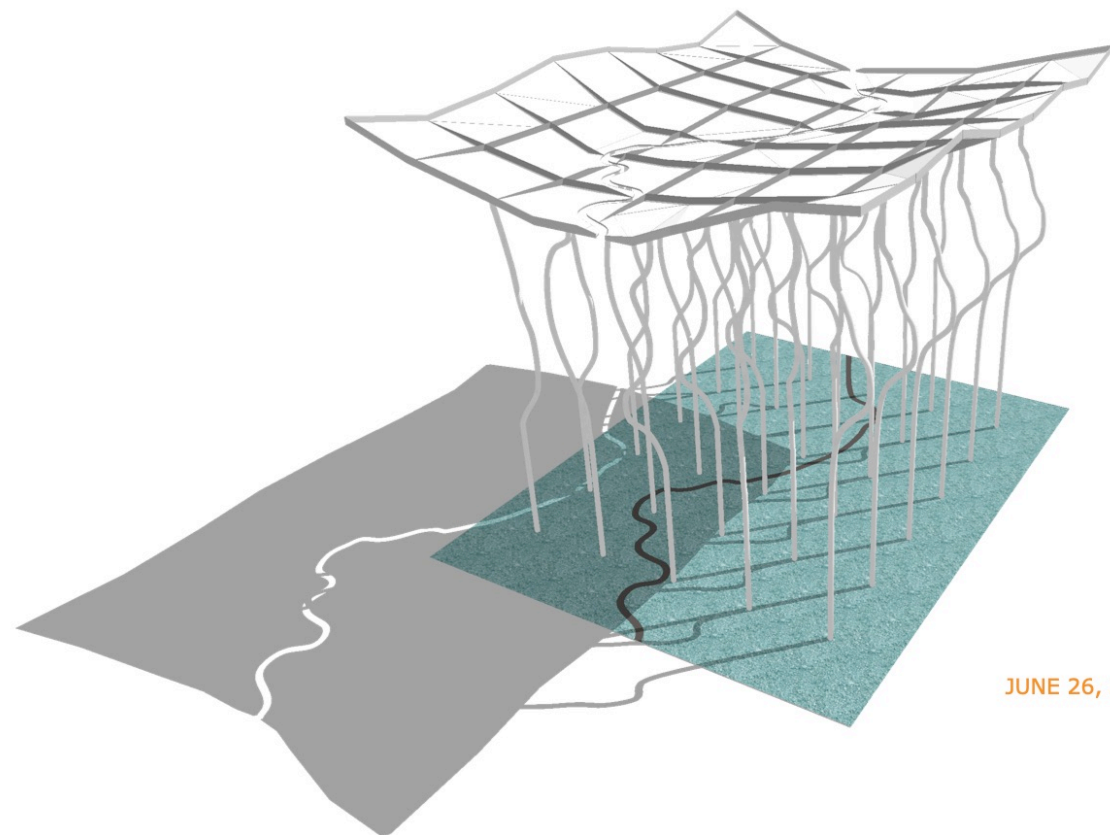

NIGHT LIGHTING

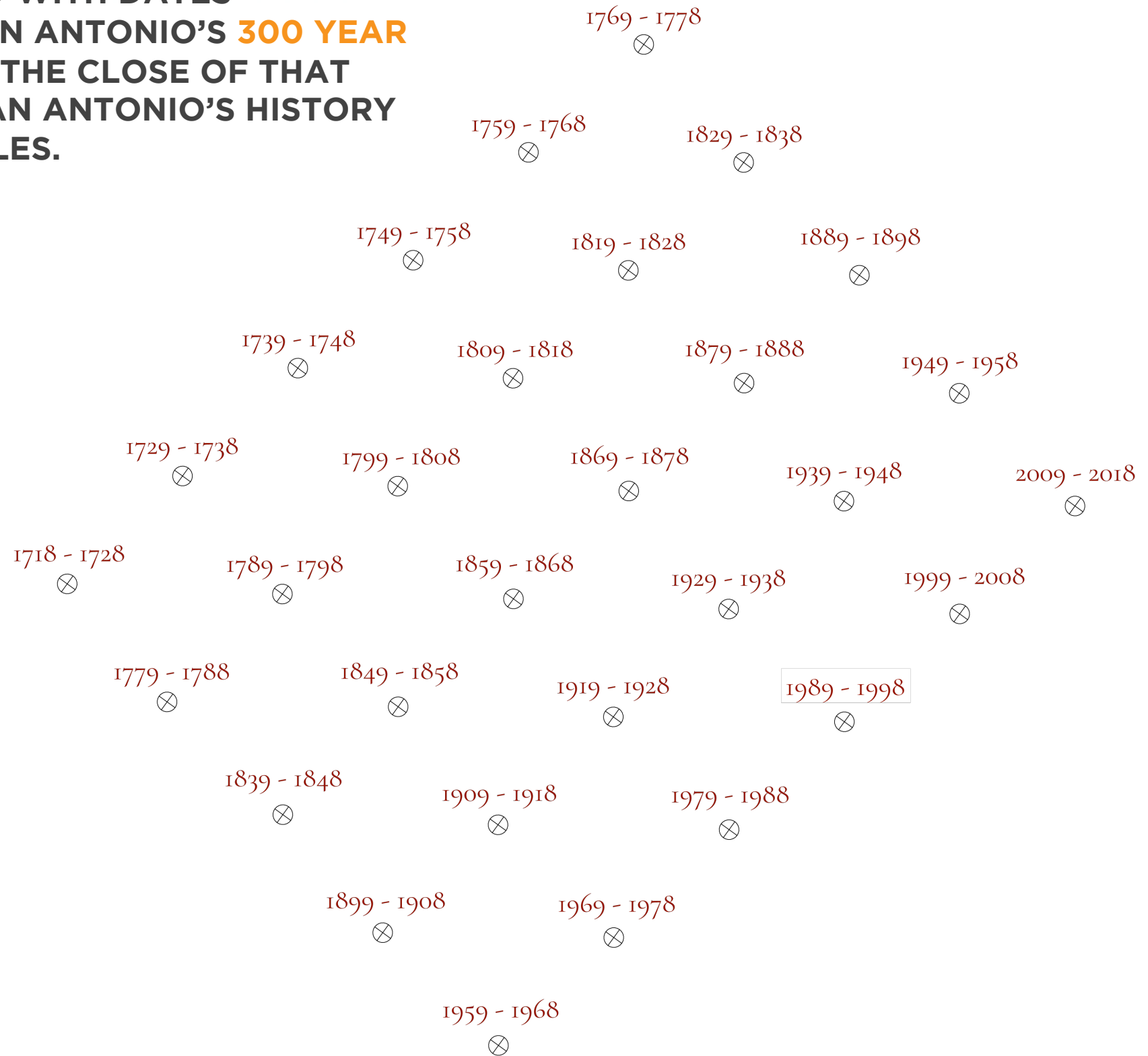

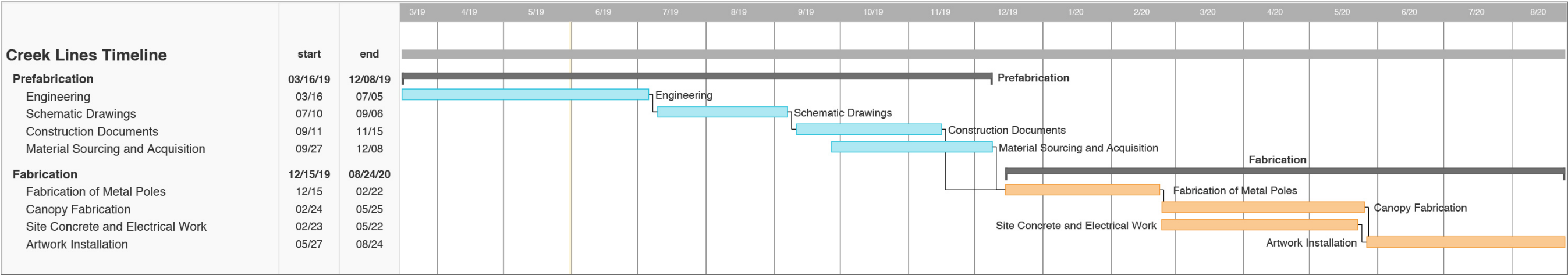
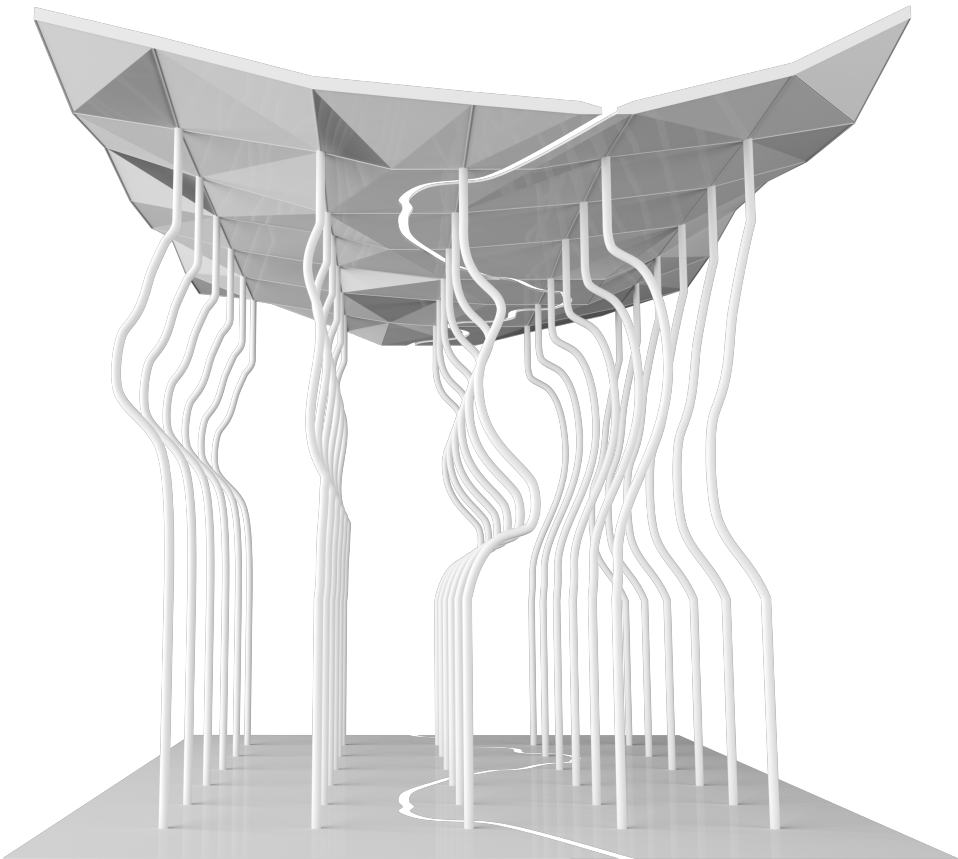
