- Rains from the Heavens update
- Alameda Mural Vandalism



Rains From the Heavens

- Application began May 2020 and was completed in June



- Within weeks of the application, the algae returned
- Scheduled cleaning



Warranty Claim

- Staff pressure washed the panels
- Coating seemed to flake off
- Original clear coating was only 9ml thick
- Possible unsuccessful application of their product



Re-Coated Panels



- Second application made at a 24 ml thickness
- Contractor feels the thicker coating will help keep the product from flaking off of the structure and help prevent the algae accumulation
- Water is scheduled to be turned back on by August 14th.

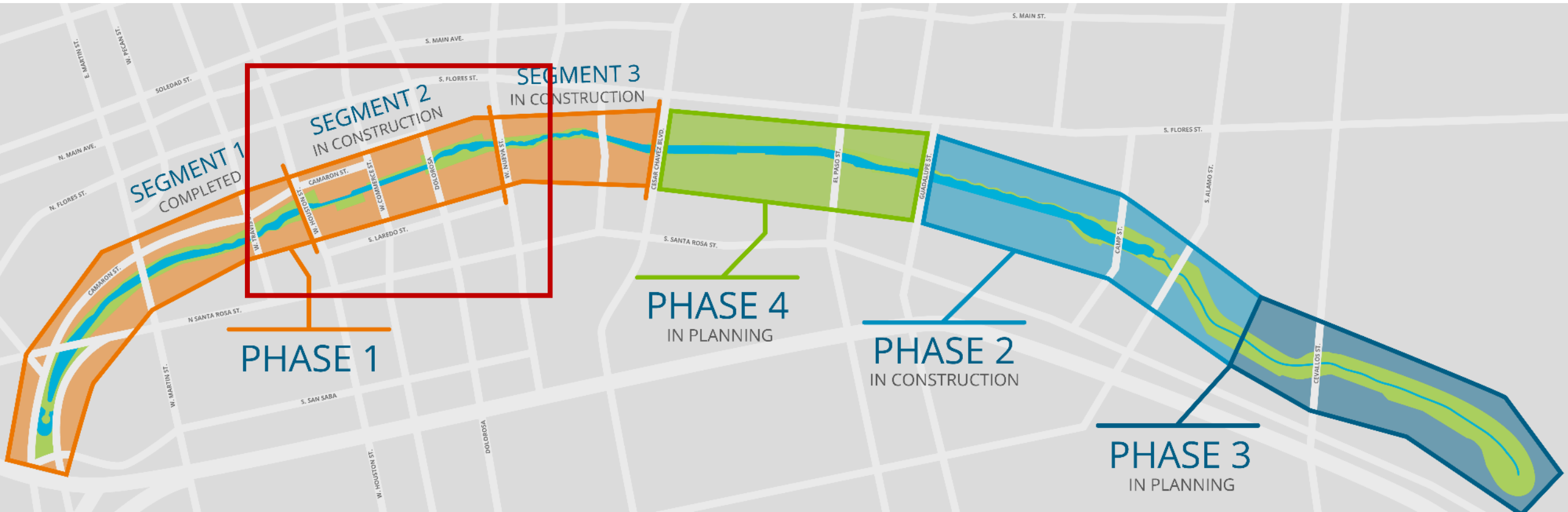

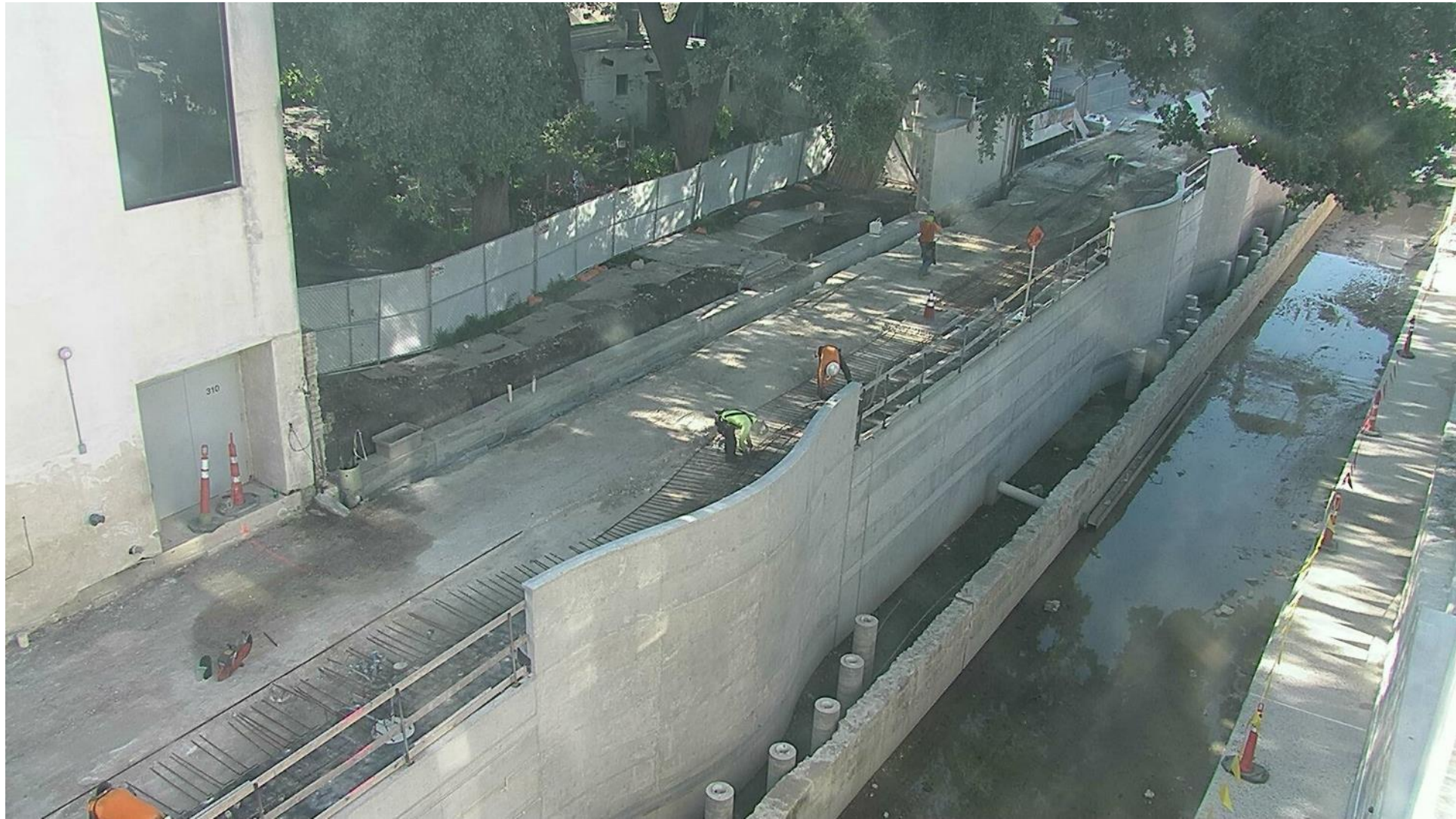

- Current substantial completion October 2021

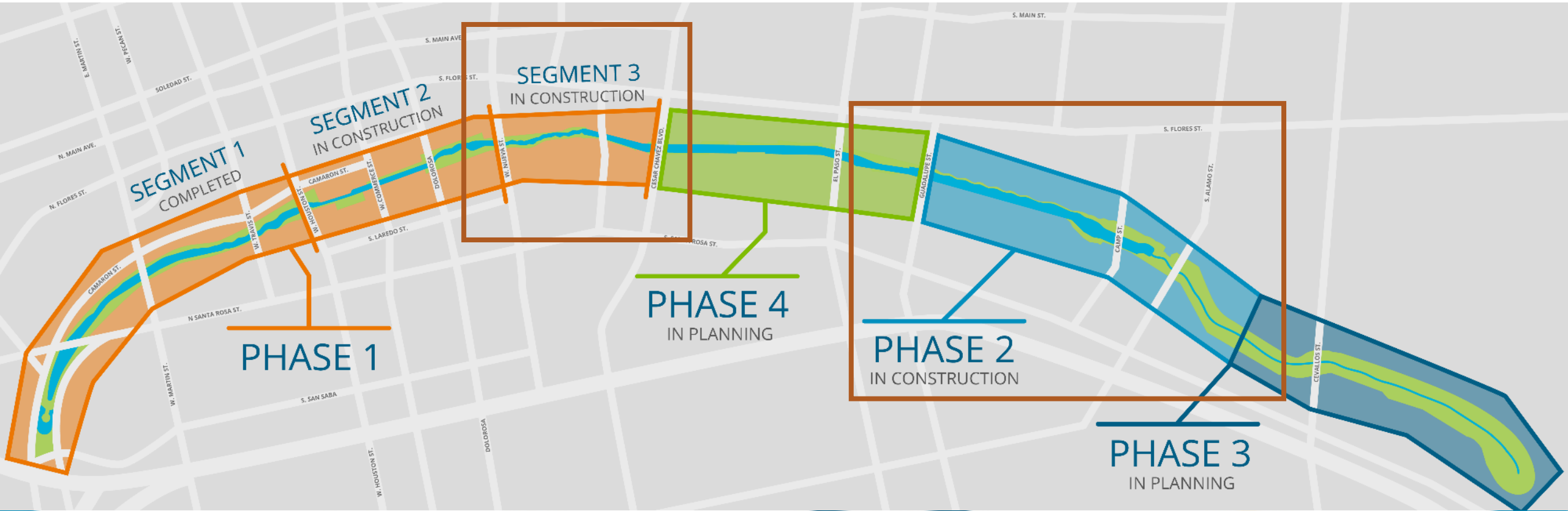

 - GMP submittal September 30



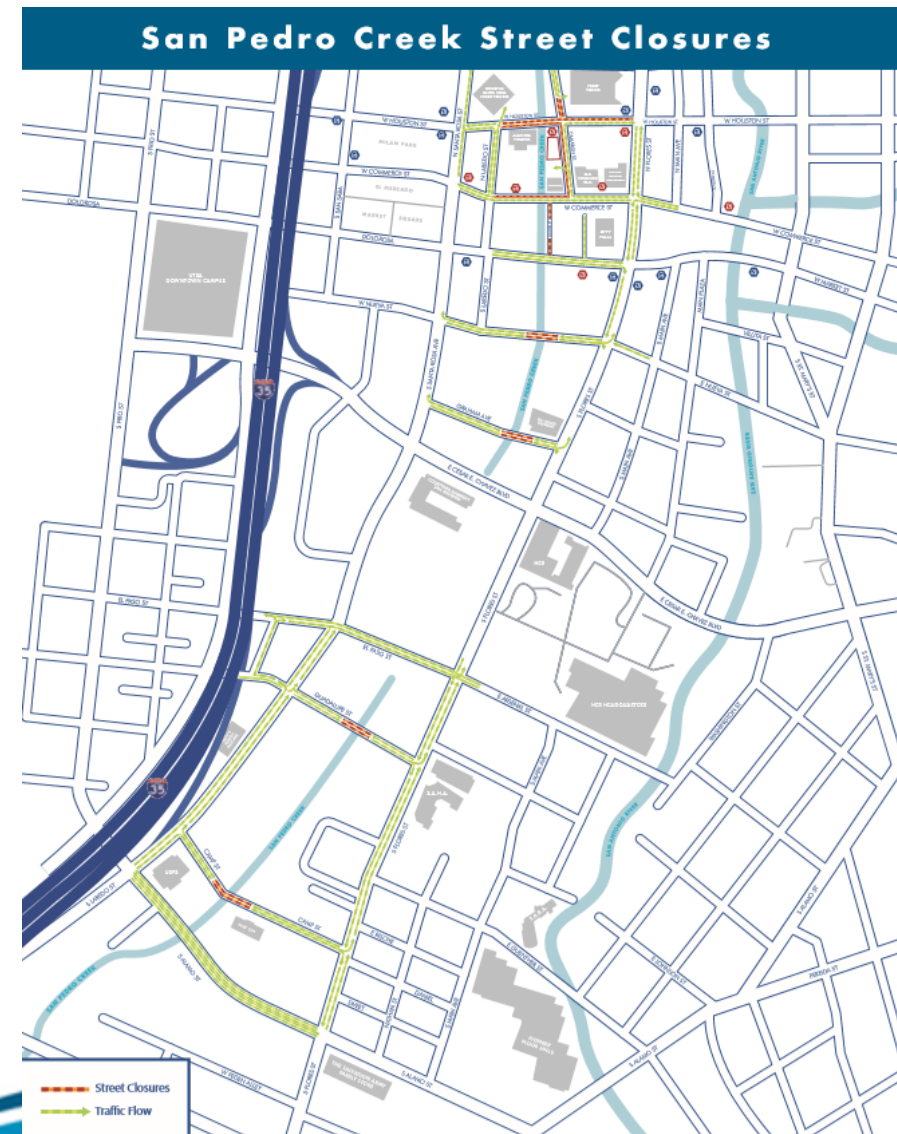
Phase 1.3 and Phase 2 Construction
