Operations and Maintenance

- Rains from the Heavens update
- Annual Inspection



Rains From the Heavens

- Coating application began May 2020 and was completed in June
- Pressure washed in July
- Coating began to flake off
- Vendor and contractor agreed it was unsuccessful due to their application.





Re-Coated Panels



- Second application was made at a 24 ml thickness vs 9ml
- Contractor felt the thicker coating would help keep the product from flaking off of the structure and help prevent the algae accumulation
- Water was turned back on August 14th.



- Wall is experiencing flaking of the pigmented coating again
- SARA has provided the vendor with two panels that were perforated additional coating tests
- Results meeting scheduled for 11/12/2020
- River Authority still seeking warranty resolution.





Annual Inspection

- Phase 1.1 annual inspection took place on 10/28/2020
- Representatives were present from:
 - The River Authority
 - CoSA-TCI, CCDO
 - Bexar County
- Discussed benches, paseos, landscaping, Rains of Heaven, warranty items, etc
- Overall the inspection went well. There were a couple of items that will be addressed by River Authority staff while others will go to the project team for review.


- Historic Significance Identification

 - Approved mitigation plan is put into an MOA which allows construction work in the area to proceed




Phase 1.3 and Phase 2 Construction






