 - Nueva Street underground electric and gas work ongoing
- Ph. 2: Guadalupe to RR Bridge

 - Southern half of Alamo bridge moving along quickly; traffic switch expected in April


Street closures



PHASE 1.2: *Stream* by Adam Frank


- Water Wall mockup on February 2, have solution to achieve desired effect


