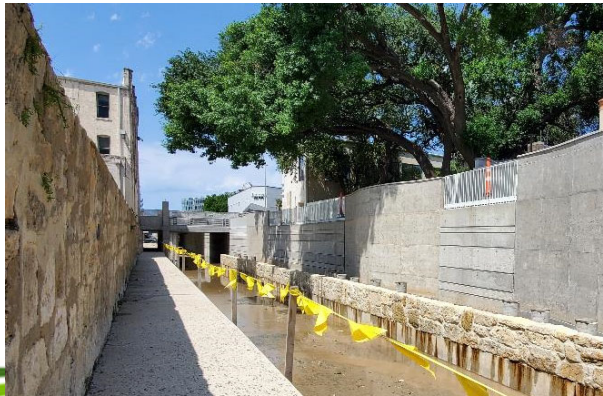

# Phase 1.2 Construction

- Railing installation ongoing
- Houston CDS work almost complete, groundwater treatment system demobilized





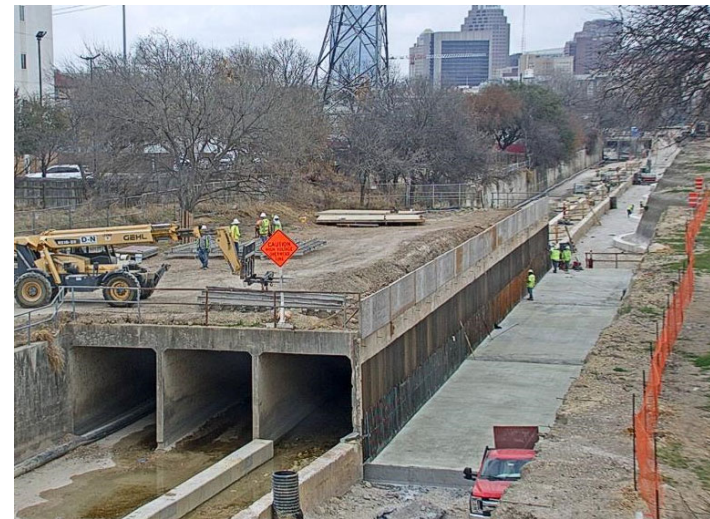
# Phase 1.3 and Phase 2 Construction

- Ph. 1.3: Graham to Cesar Chavez
  - Removal of treatment system allows work to start on the bioretention pond on the new federal courthouse property
  - Installing Nueva crest gate hydraulic lines
  - Nueva Street water line work starting in the next couple of weeks



# Phase 1.3 and Phase 2 Construction

- Ph. 2: Guadalupe to RR Bridge
  - Camp transmission tower has been relocated
  - Completed additional field work for Feature 67, submitting report to agencies for review
  - Alamo traffic switch expected early next week, will maintain pedestrian access across Alamo



## Phase 3 and 4 Design

- Received comments this week from UPRR for Phase 3 railroad bridge design
- Received 60% design plans
- Expecting Ph. 3 & 4 pricing by May 21<sup>st</sup>
- Phase 4: Setting up follow up meetings with hotel owners

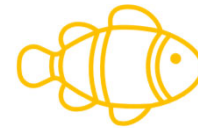
