

Park Features:

- artistic design feature (metal screening) around flood bypass tunnel - depicting the night sky in 1718 (in partnership with the Scobee Planetarium)
- tile murals that tell the story of how San Pedro Creek brought forth life, growth, and diversity in our community
- locations of historical text and poetry by John Phillip Santos etched in the limestone walls along the creek
- colorful tile designs by Michael Menchaca commemorating the people, culture and history of our community
