San Pedro Creek Project: Phase 1.2

Houston Street to Nueva Street

- Completed reconstruction of the AME west wall
- Installing interior restroom walls
- Installed wider sidewalk along Camaron





San Pedro Creek Project: Phase 1.2

Houston Street to Nueva Street

- Installed railing and light poles on paseo adjacent to Alameda Theater
- Began installing tile on high paseo benches along Calder Alley
- Planted trees north of Commerce






San Pedro Creek Project: Phase 1.3

Nueva Street to C. Chavez Blvd

 Planted trees between Dolorosa and Graham

- Pouring curbs on Nueva Street
- Releasing water in channel between Houston and Cesar Chavez next week





San Pedro Creek Project: Phase 2

Guadalupe Street to S. Alamo Street

- Placing light pole foundations along paseo south of Guadaulpe
- Received final elements of Alamo gate, proceeding with installing them
- Alamo gatehouse: completed exterior stucco, began installation of roof
- Installed irrigation line under Alamo



San Pedro Creek Project: Phase 3


Railroad Bridge to Confluence w/ Apache Creek

- Installing water line on east bank between railroad bridge and Cevallos
- Began installing limestone block walls and storm sewer lines starting near IH 35
- Reducing width of road on Cevallos bridge starting at the end of August

- Pump pit update



Rains from Heaven

- A coating to help protect the feature and reduce pressure washing was applied in July 2020 removal occurred by the vendor on September 1, 2021due to below performance expectations.
- River Authority staff is evaluated options to relocate the waterfall feature to beneath the stainless-steel panels to eliminate constant water flow over the panelscurrently under design.
- The look and sound of falling water will remain
- The scrim will be put back up behind the feature to depict the night sky






Pump Pit Update

- Cracks and stress fractures have been observed by River Authority staff on the vertical outlet pipes in the pump pit.
- As an interim approach, a vendor was selected to repair cracking through arc welding.
- Current coordination with HDR regarding the materials and design
- Permanent repair/solution is the long term goal






