San Pedro Creek Project: Phase 3

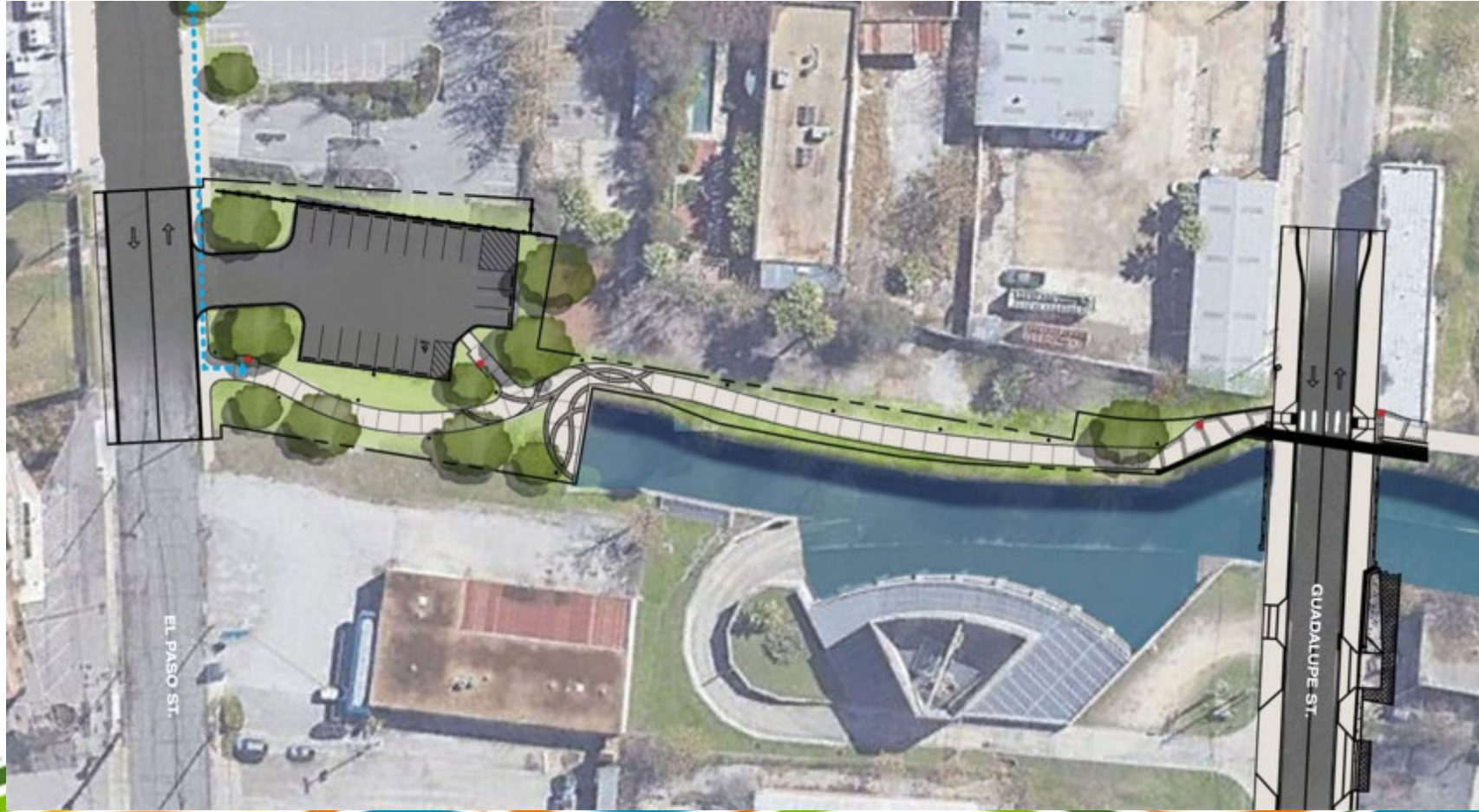
Railroad Bridge to Confluence w/ Apache Creek

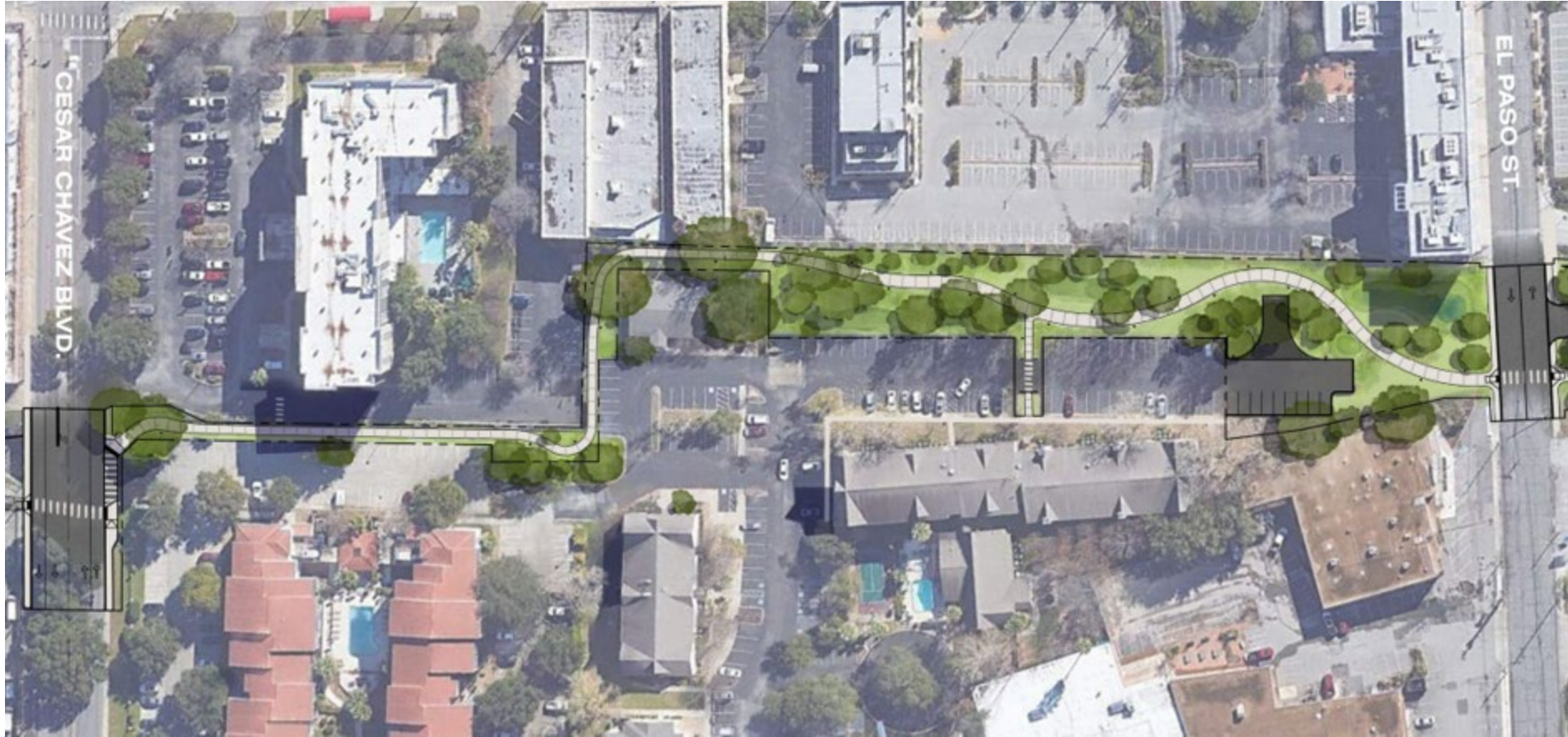

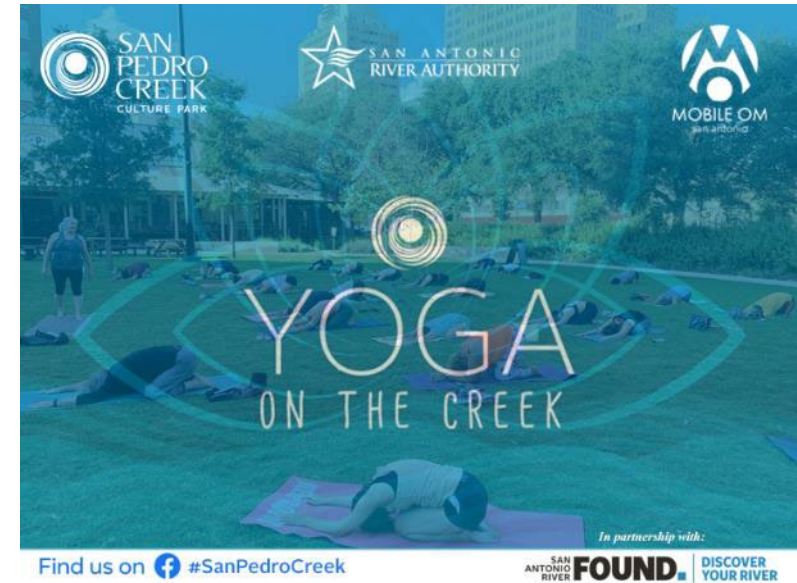
