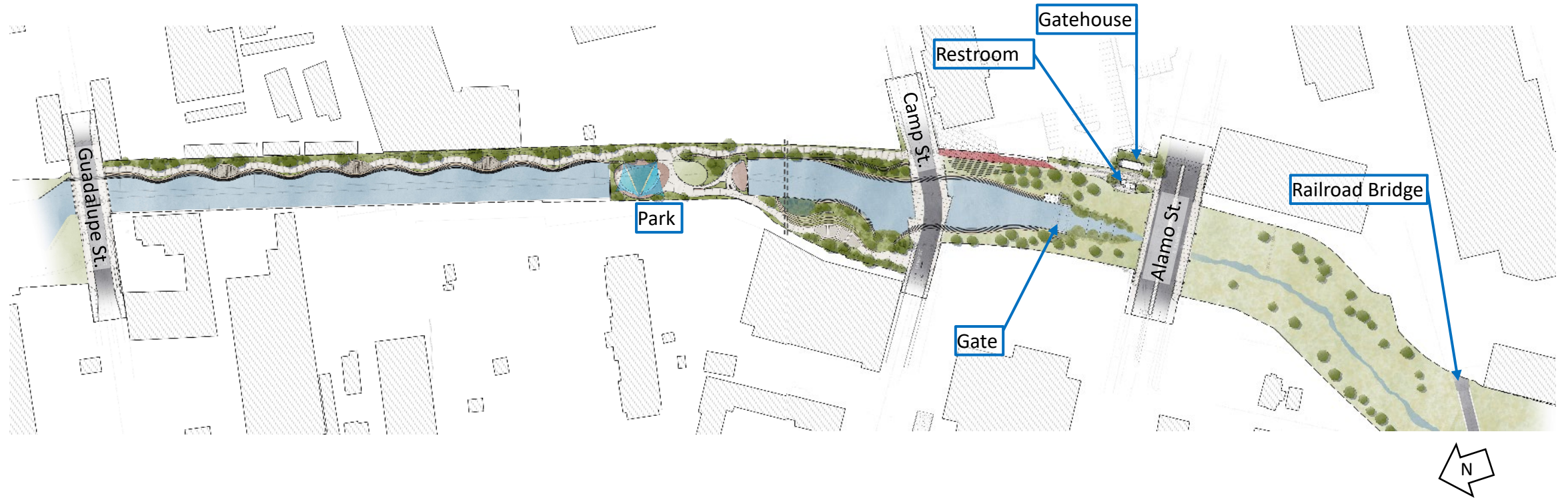

- Actively grading and installing paseos

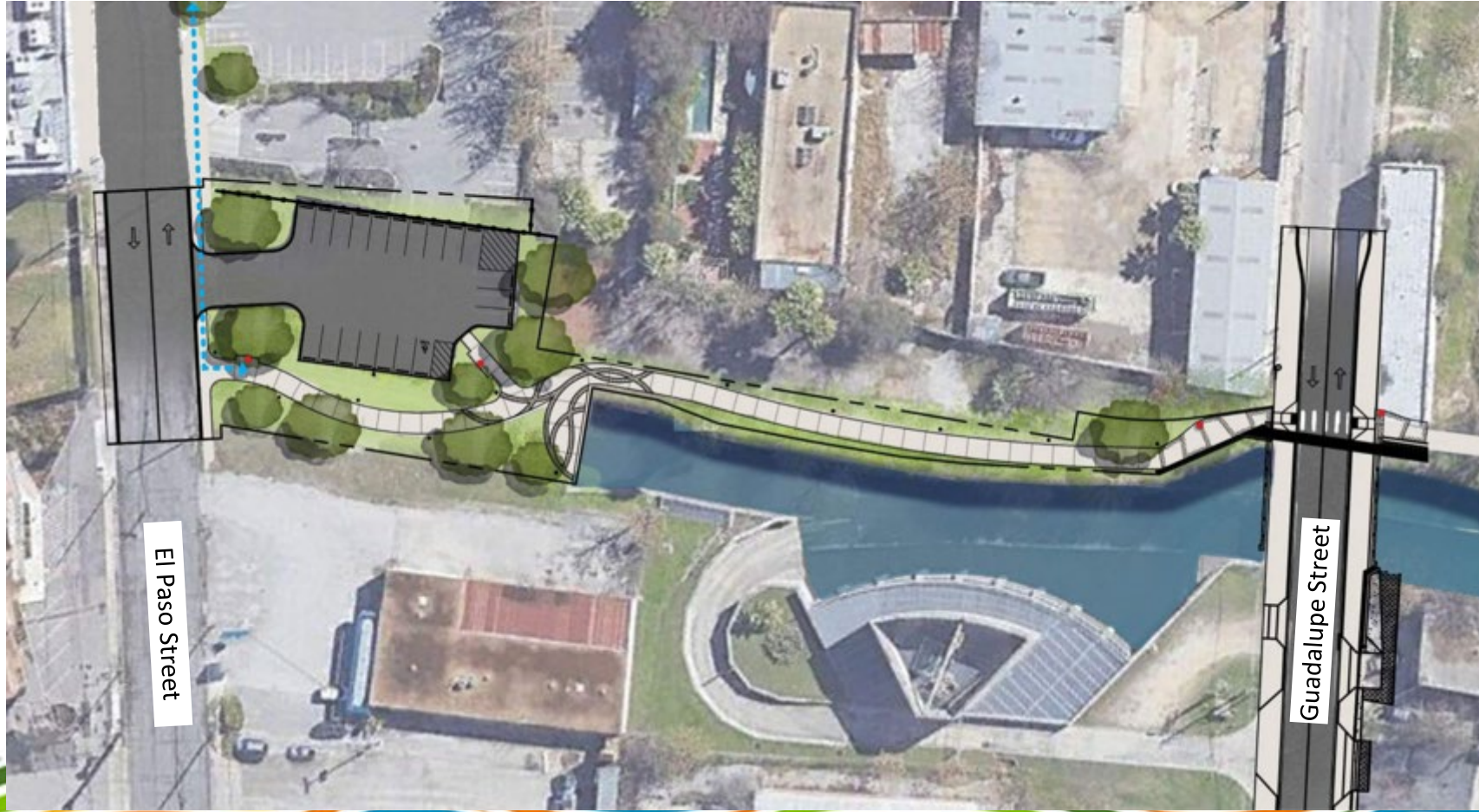


Phase 3 Channel as seen from the east bank of the creek facing northwest

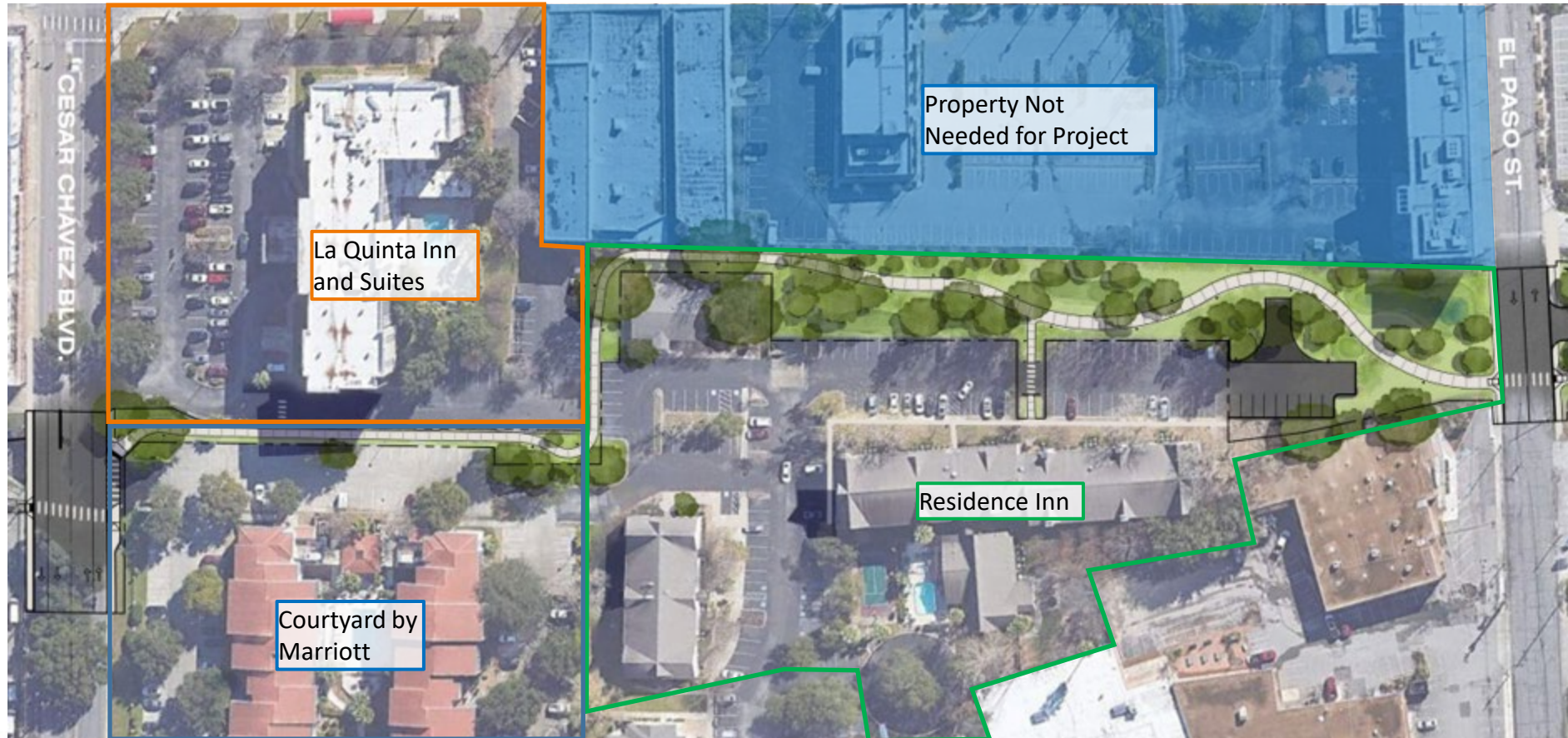

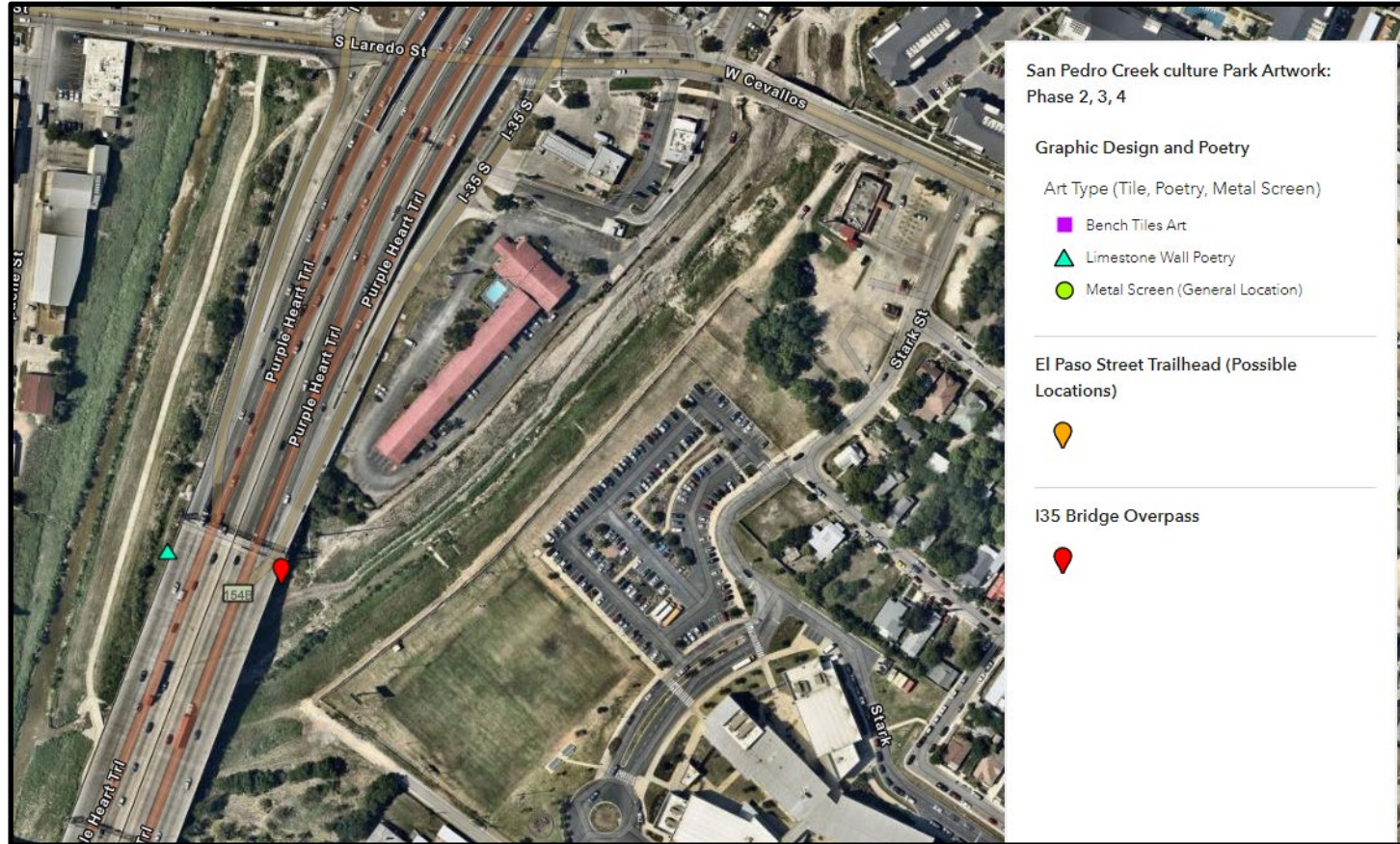

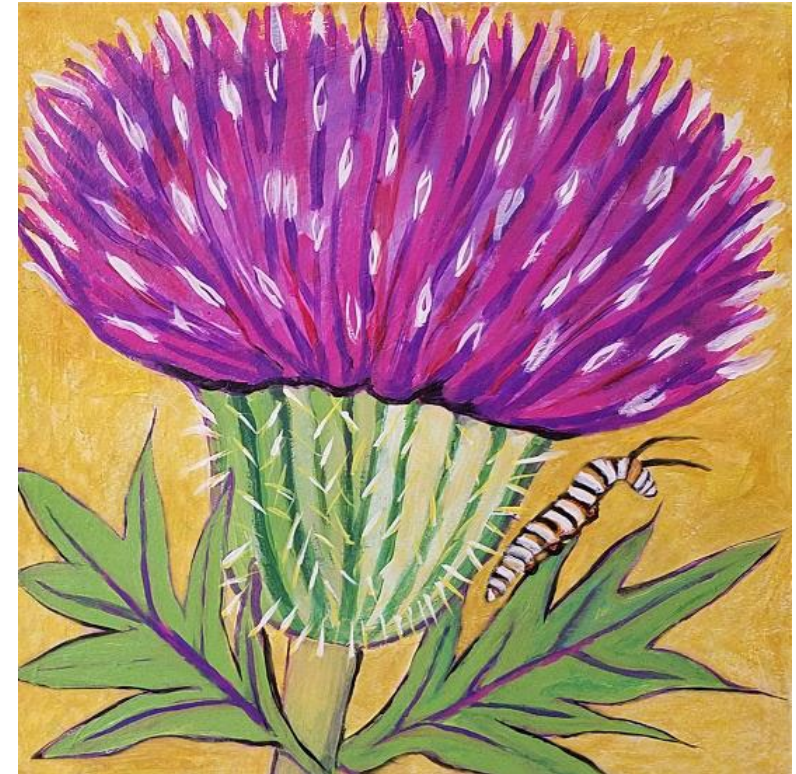
