

Punch List Items



Rain from Heavens

- 2020- Coating applied to help protect the feature and reduce cleaning frequency.
- 2021- Coating was removed by the vendor given below performance expectations.
- 2022- River Authority staff evaluated options to relocate the waterfall feature to beneath the stainless-steel panels to eliminate constant water flow over the panels. The structural design has been completed and sent to HDR for verification of flows and final design.
- Final design of the ROH should be complete by the end of March and will solicite for bids in April.
- Anticipated construction to start by the end of May or in early June






Adam Franks Stream Microphone

January 18, 2023, repaired with improvements








Punch List Items

- Flood gate, hydraulics, and controls are moving toward final installation
